Denis Croze is Director of the Regional Office of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO), located in Singapore, since June 2012.

Prior to this, Mr. Croze held various positions at WIPO, such as Director of the Assemblies and Documentation Affairs Division (AADD) in the Office of the Director General (2010 -2012), Acting Director Advisor in the Executive Office of the Deputy Director General in charge of the Copyright and Enforcement Sector (2006 – 2009), Acting Director Advisor in the Executive Office of the Deputy Director General, Economic Development Sector (2004 - 2006), Head of the International Law Development Section (2002 – 2004) and Head of the Trademark Law Section in the Industrial Property Law Division of WIPO (1999 – 2002).

Mr. Croze headed the Multilateral Affairs Department of the French Patent and Trademark Office (INPI) in Paris, France from 1996 to 1999, and was Consultant at WIPO to set up the WIPO Mediation and Arbitration Center from 1994 to 1996. His previous experiences were with the International Chamber of Commerce (ICC) in Paris as Head of the Legal Division (1990-1994) and as an Attorney with the Office of Legal Affairs of the United Nations in New York (1987-1990).

Denis Croze, a national of France, holds a DEA (Master) in International Economic Law from the University of Paris II (Assas) and a DEA in Political Science from the University of Paris I (Panthéon-Sorbonne). He also followed the Program of Instruction for Lawyers (PIL) of the Harvard Law School.
