Dr. Kevin Luo is the General Manager of Microsoft's Asia R&D Group. He is responsible for all legal matters for the Group. The Asia R&D Group, headquartered in Beijing, is Microsoft's largest R&D group outside the US. Dr. Luo is also responsible for China's IP and security policy and he is also an Assistant General Counsel of Microsoft Corporation.

Prior to the current responsibility, Dr. Luo was the Associate General Counsel for Patents for Microsoft's Server and Tools Business, a US\$16 billion business. Dr. Luo had also been the Director of IP Licensing, Senior Licensing Counsel, and the lead patent attorney for Windows Division at Microsoft.

Before joining Microsoft in 1999, Dr. Luo had been in private practice with the former law firm of Pennie & Edmonds LLP in New York City for 7 years.

Dr. Luo holds a J.D. from Fordham University Law School; Ph.D. and M.A. from Columbia University, both in electrical engineering. Dr. Luo graduated from Tsinghua University, Beijing with a B.S. in electrical engineering. He is the Vice Chairman of the Asia Practice Committee of the Intellectual Property Owners Association (IPO).
