

Calvin Park

Calvin Park is Senior Director and Legal Counsel at Qualcomm Incorporated. Calvin Park has been with Qualcomm since January 2007. At Qualcomm, Calvin Park has the oversight of the company's licensing business and legal affairs in Korea.

Calvin Park received J.D. from University of California Berkeley Law School in 1999, and he started his career as a patent attorney at Lyon & Lyon, LLP, in California, specializing in both patent litigation and prosecution. Since joining Qualcomm in early 2007, Calvin Park has been involved with the matters in anti-trust and intellectual property, and he has been the company's main contact and interface with the regulatory agencies in Korea including the Korea Fair Trade Commission.

Calvin Park is a member of "Standards and Patents" Committee of AIPPI; a Vice Chair of Asia Pacific Committee of the ABA International Law Section; and a member of IPR Expert Committee of TTA (main SSO of telecommunications in Korea). Calvin Park is considered one of the few legal professionals in Korea who has the expertise in both intellectual property and anti-trust laws, and he is frequently invited to speak in various conferences and seminars on the topics of FRAND and Standard Essential Patents. Calvin Park was a contributing writer to ABA Handbook on Anti-Trust for the section dedicated to Korea

Calvin Park received Asialaw Journal's In-House Counsel of the Year 2007 Award for South Korea and also was voted as one of the TOP25 In-House Counsel by Asia Legal Business Journal in 2007. Calvin Park was one of the finalists for the Global Competition Review's In-House Counsel of the Year Award in 2014.

Before joining Qualcomm, Calvin Park served as the Head of Licensing and International Legal Affairs at the Pantech Group, where he led Pantech's international legal matters ranging from licensing to complex IP litigation.
